Jack Harris (18), Will Lowery (7), and Luke Moore (3) are the first Eagles made by our impressive junior golfers

Love the excitement on the course as members are entering eagles on their cards, rolling in putts and chipping in shots for kids in our community. Great Playing!!

Below you will also see a few notes on this incredible program and answers to questions that have come up.

- In a few weeks we will outline the process of submitting nominations for Children's Charities that hold the deepest ties to the golf members of our Chatham Hills community. THIS IS THE REAL MEANING behind our Eagles for Children program.
- Now that we have some data on our Eagles made, we can estimate what your family contribution would be for this program. Assuming another 14 Eagles from June September, plus the 18 that have already been made. your charitable contribution would be \$296. This is roughly the individual cost of playing in a golf scramble, but the aggregated benefit to children in our community would be approximately \$90,000!
- Please remember to call the pro shop or stop by after your round to have your attested gross eagle recorded.
- Even if you opted-out of the EFC program your eagle still counts and raises money for our children's charities. There are no penalty strokes for opting back into the EFC

- program at any time or making a one-time donation (\$2,000 raised to date in one-time donations).
- Every quarter, 100% of all money raised will be wired to the EFC Foundation in Michigan. The Foundation will return 100% of our money in the form of checks to our selected charities in October / November as well as send out all charitable tax documents to all participating members in January.
