

## Eagles for Children: Applying for a Grant

Chatham Hill Members,

Eagles for Children is now accepting grant applications, through September 15, for 2025 funding. We invite local charities making a direct impact on children to apply for support.

Chatham Hills members should direct a local children's charity, that they will sponsor, to the EFC web site: [Eagles for Children® - Applying for a Grant | Grants](#), or copy the sample Non-Profit Referral letter from the google docs link below.

Sponsoring simply means you and another club member (cannot be your spouse) know and support the organization's mission, and you're encouraging funding their work.

On this site, the charity can begin the application process (there is a \$100 charge to apply). The application process is completed when two CH member sponsors receive an email from the grants platform ([ADMIN@COMMUNITYFORCE.COM](mailto:ADMIN@COMMUNITYFORCE.COM)) and acknowledge that they are sponsors of the children's charity by entering the club name & their membership number.

- *Grants will only be awarded to qualifying 501(c)3 public charities serving children.*
- *Grant awards will range from \$1000 - \$7000 per club.*
- *Charities can request a grant from up to 3 local EFC Clubs, if member sponsors from those clubs are available. Local participating EFC Clubs are Holiday Farms, Woodland CC, Broadmoor CC, and Hillview CC.*
- *Applications are due September 15, 2025.*

This grant application process is new to us at Chatham Hills but has been in place for over a decade. Please feel free to reach out to Emily Andersen, Tina Burks, Roger Harvey, or Gary Warzala if you or your sponsoring charity have any questions. If we don't know the answer, we have a great EFC support team that will get the answers quickly.
